This program offers 1L law students the opportunity to work side by side with Lowenstein Sandler attorneys, a Leadership Council on Legal Diversity (LCLD) Member law firm, during our summer associate program. The program also includes the opportunity to attend the 2022 1L LCLD Scholars Summit. Candidates must be currently enrolled, full-time 1L students at accredited law schools.

The 2022 LS Scholars Program offers positions in our Roseland, New Jersey and New York, New York offices with a weekly salary of **\$3,950.00**. In addition, after successful completion of the 1L Summer Associate Program, 2022 LS Scholars will receive a **\$10,000 scholarship** for second-year tuition and related fees. If LS Scholars are offered and accept Summer Associate positions with Lowenstein Sandler for their 2L summer and they remain in good standing during their 2L academic year, they will receive a **\$15,000 scholarship** for third-year tuition and related fees after successful completion of the 2L Summer Associate Program.
